PEER-TO-PEER FUNDRAISING CHOOSING AN EVENT

Peer-to-peer (P2P) fundraising is a powerful method for organizations to raise money. Many organizations are creating peer-to-peer fundraising events to serve as their organization's primary fundraising vehicle, or adding events to supplement their existing fundraising and outreach programs. Contrary to popular belief, you don't always need a dedicated events team or an army of volunteers to make your event successful, but you do need proper planning. We've created this A to G outline to help you evaluate your organization's readiness for peer-to-peer fundraising.
