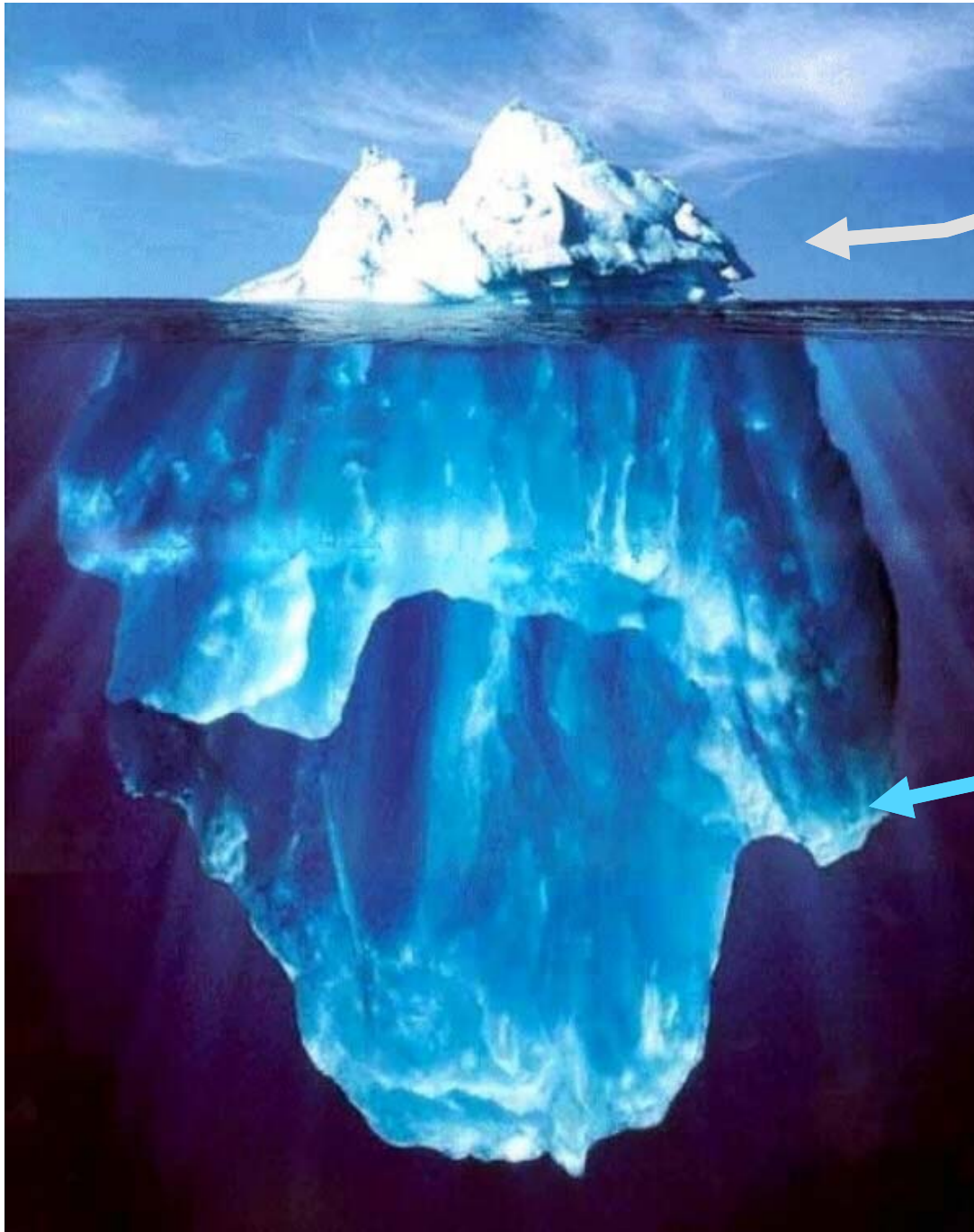

Top 5 Problems My Clients Face

Challenges prior to Common Ground

- Unreliable data
- Minimal automation
- Obsolete database
- Limited reporting capabilities
